



Phoenix Art Space - Winter Studio Residency 2026

Wednesday 7 January – Sunday 15 February 2026

The offer

Each winter we offer our Main Gallery as a hireable shared studio for 6 weeks and for 2026 we're extending the offer to include our Project Space.

We are now inviting applications for the Winter 2026 cohort. We welcome artists working in any medium whose practice would be compatible with working in a shared communal environment.

Full details of the offer and how to apply are below.

The spaces

The Main Gallery will be divided into three main areas each around 30 square metres and suitable for an individual or an artist duo.

The Rear Gallery is slightly more private; it is around 22 square metres and would also be suitable for individual or an artist duo.

All of these spaces provide an open plan, warm, clean space with good natural light, 24-hour access and free Wi-Fi.

The Project Space is a more contained room of around 56 square metres and would be ideal for a small collective, though we would also welcome applications from individual and artist duos. It is equipped with a projector, speakers and is warm and clean with 24-hour access and free Wi-Fi.

All spaces have access to a store with a cold-water sink.

Studio Costs

- Main Gallery Spaces: £450 each
- Rear Gallery: £510
- Project Space: £600

These costs are for the full period and will be invoiced on acceptance, a payment plan can be negotiated.

Other costs

There is a refundable deposit of £50. This will be returned at the end of the residency subject to all materials, works, furniture and waste being removed.

There is a refundable deposit of £20 per person per swipe card/key. This will be refunded to you at the end of the residency once they have been returned.

Access

The Main Gallery is situated on our ground floor, which is wheelchair accessible, with entry via a ramp to the left of the main entrance stairs. Other than a slight ramp into the Main Gallery, the rest of the ground floor is on one level and includes the café and toilets. Unfortunately, our upper floor studios and office are only accessible by stairs.

Support

Our curator, Laurence Hill, works most days across the week and is available for studio visits and general support. There are also opportunities for support and/or conversation from team members responsible for Learning and Community Engagement and Marketing.

Feedback from a 2025 Winter Resident - *The residency was an incredibly positive experience for me. It allowed me to develop my art practice, in ways that wouldn't have been possible, without the time and space that the residency provided. I particularly appreciated the flexible structure of the residency, the amount of space we had to work in, and getting to know the other artists within the shared space. There was continuous communication from staff at Phoenix which meant that I always felt like there was someone available if I had any questions.*

An artist statement including links to your website and social media - max 250 words.

A covering letter outlining:

- How this opportunity would benefit you and your practice - max 250 words.
- Details of any specific project you would use the space for if applicable - max 250 words.
- An outline of any access needs you might have and how we could support them – max 250 words.

Six images of your recent work in jpeg format - please include your name and the title of the work in the file name.

If your work is film or performance-based please send: a showreel video or maximum 3 examples as MP4 files – each no more than 3 minutes. Or send links to a video portal (e.g. Vimeo) or website.
